The Poem Project

- Poems must be about one of the animals or instruments in the orchestral piece *Peter & the Wolf* by Sergei Prokofiev. (CD included)



Poems should be short, preferably no longer than 14 lines.

Poems need not rhyme.

- Consider a wide variety of poetry forms. Some suggestions are ABC poems, blank verse, couplets, epigrams, free verse, haiku, limericks, quatrains, or sonnets. You are not limited to this list.

- Poems may be funny or serious.



The Art Project

- Paintings must be about one of the animals or instruments in orchestral piece *Peter & the Wolf* by Sergei Prokofiev.
- Consider a wide variety of art media – oils, watercolors, collage, charcoal, etc.
- Paintings may be funny or serious, but need to be bright enough to be seen at a distance. (Size: 16' by 20' or to be determined with the art teachers and materials available.)

The Mask Project

- Masks should represent one of the animals or an instrument.
- Masks should be oversized and may be wearable or hand-held by an actor or the creator.
- Consider all manner of materials from feathers to tree bark.
